

The success of Kunamokst Lodge events depends on the conduct of every event participant. As an Arrowman and a member of Scouting America, I understand that my behavior ensures the safety and enjoyment of all participants.

As a participant of a Kunamokst Lodge event, I (printed name) \_\_\_\_\_ will:

- Abide by the Scout Oath, Scout Law, and Order of the Arrow Obligation.
- Follow all Safeguarding Youth (Youth Protection) guidelines, including those regarding digital communications and social media.
- Respect designated quiet hours and “lights out” times to ensure everyone gets proper rest.
- Not change my officially assigned sleeping quarters without permission from the event leadership.
- Allow no other person to be in or occupy my sleeping quarters, other than those assigned by the event leadership.
- Wear suitable and appropriate clothing and footwear at all times during the event.
- Observe all rules regarding camp or event facilities, including but not limited to the waterfront, ranges, climbing tower, and program areas.
- Follow the “Buddy System” at all times and adhere to the Guide to Safe Scouting.
- Keep my sleeping quarters clean and orderly and dispose of trash in proper receptacles.
- Wear the Scouting field uniform to all ceremonies, flags, and dinner. The Scouting activity uniform is appropriate for all other times.
- Refrain from the purchase, possession, or consumption of alcoholic beverages, illicit drugs, or marijuana products at the event. These are not permitted and will result in immediate dismissal from the event and notification of the Scout executive. This standard applies to all participants, guests, and vendors.
- Refrain from using any tobacco products while at the event, including vaping.
- Comply with federal, state, and city laws and host facility regulations, including those that prohibit the use of fireworks, firearms, and gambling. Infraction of these laws and regulations will cause immediate dismissal from the event.
- Be a positive role model for other Scouts and Scouters through my actions and speech.
- Be respectful to all participants, their personal space, and property.
- Remain on camp approved camp property and sign out at the registration table if I must leave the property for any reason.
- Not sell items at events. The trading post, auction, and approved vendors are the only source for sale/purchase of memorabilia and materials at conclave.
- Be personally and financially responsible for breakage, damage, or loss of property.

I understand that I am a guest of Kunamokst Lodge, Pacific Crest Council, and the host facility. I understand that a violation of this Code of Conduct may result in immediate dismissal from the event and potential expulsion from future lodge activities. All decisions regarding violations will be made by lodge and council leadership and are final.
